

To Re-direct Interrogatories filed with the Commission by the Complainant and herewith returned, the said Warren G. Welsh, Deposes & says, to the 1st. Q. D. Int: What was to become of the money on the Eagle note note upon which judgment was obtained, in the event of the money being collected?

Ans: It was to be paid to Jacob Fogle or Mrs. Fogle in the same manner as the other rents were paid.

2^d. Q. D. Int: Did you receive said note as a payment to you, or as to be applied to the payment of the Mortgage?

Ans: I received the said note, with the consent of Mr. Fogle; I would not take the note without their consent, as it was a matter of theirs, and not of mine. If it was collected, I was to pay the money over to them.

Whereupon, there being no other witnesses present to be examined, and no further time being required for production of evidences upon the part of the Complainant, the Commission closed the said Commission and herewith returns the same under his hand and seal, on this 5th. day of July A. D. Eighteen hundred and seventy seven.
