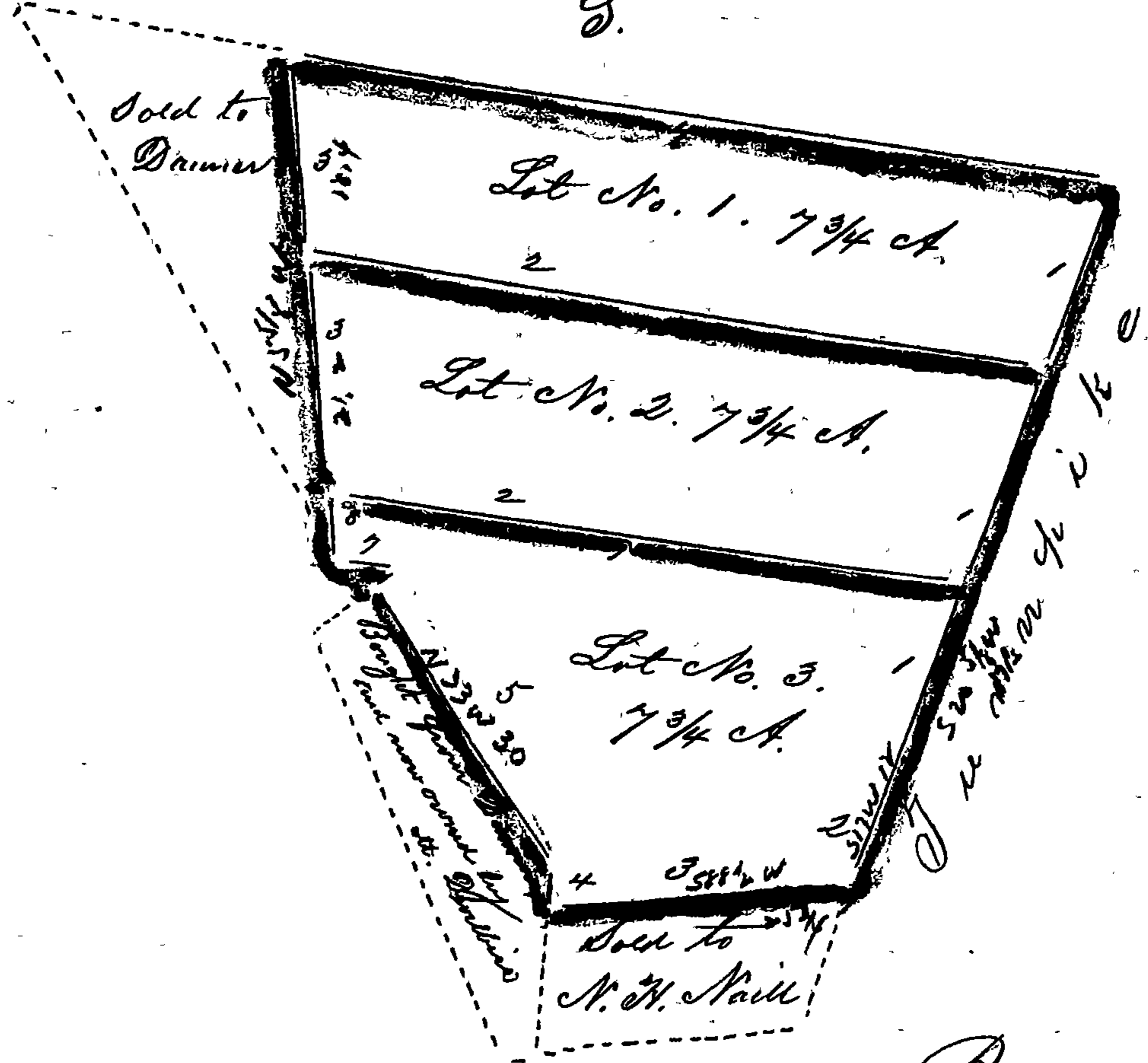
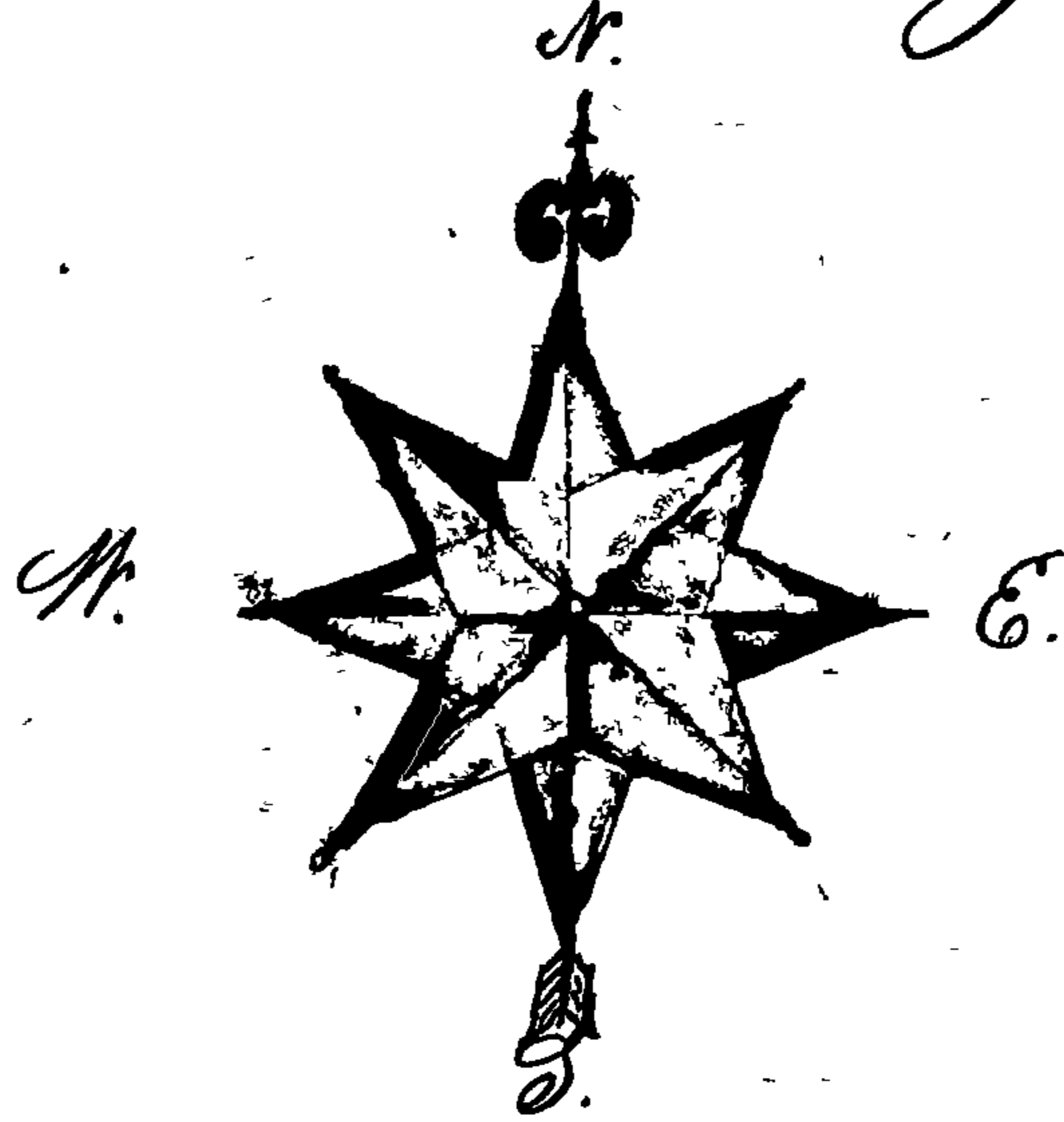

North $5\frac{5}{8}^{\circ}$ West $21\frac{1}{10}$ fms. to the end of the 2nd line of Lot No. 1. and bounding them severally, ⁴. South $81\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East $65\frac{6}{10}$ fms. to the place of beginning, containing $7\frac{3}{4}$ acres of land more or less. —

Beginning for Lot No. 3. a stone planted at the end of $39\frac{1}{10}$ fms. on the second line of the whole parcel conveyed as aforesaid by Wm. Duddan and wife, to the said Isaac C. Merdemon, and running thence with said 2^d line to the end thereof as now surveyed with the necessary allowance for variation South $20\frac{5}{8}^{\circ}$ West 17 fms. to a stone huetofne planted on the west side of the New Windsor & Liberty Turnpike, then continuing with said conveyance from Wm. Duddan and wife, our course, as now surveyed, ². South 17° West 12 fms. to a stone huetofne planted, then running as now surveyed to exclude land sold by the late Isaac C. Merdemon, in his life-time, ³. South $88\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West $25\frac{3}{4}$ fms. to a stone huetofne planted, ⁴. North 7° East $3\frac{7}{10}$ fms. to a stone huetofne planted, ⁵. North 33° West 30 fms. to a stone huetofne planted, ⁶. North $64\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East $2\frac{1}{2}$ fms. to a stone huetofne planted, ⁷. South 89° West $5\frac{3}{4}$ fms. to a stone huetofne planted for a corner on Luke C. Casner's Land and bounding them as now surveyed with the necessary allowance for variation ⁸. North $5\frac{5}{8}^{\circ}$ West, $6\frac{6}{10}$ fms. to the end of the 2nd line of Lot No. 2, and bounding them severally, ⁹. South $81\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ East $56\frac{1}{10}$ fms. to the place of beginning containing $7\frac{3}{4}$ acres of land more or less.
