Mealey of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of Three hundred and seventy five dollars, I the said Ormond F. Mealey do grant unto Thomas M. Mealey all my right, title, claim and interest in and to the estate of my deceased father Milton Mealey, late of Frederick County, deceased, and also all my undivided and child interest in the real estate of which my mother Lydia Mealey, late of Frederick County, dec'd. died seized and possessed. The said being Seventy four acres of land more or less, situated in Frederick County, and being the same in the possession and occupancy of said Milton Mealey at the time of his death.

Angus, Register of Wills for Frederick County, do hereby certify and attest that on the first day of September in the year 1873, Charles Wood, was by the Orphans Court of the County aforesaid, appointed guardian to James Mealey, heir of Milton Mealey and Lydia Mealey, late of Frederick County, deceased, who executed a Bond to the State of Maryland, in the penal sum of Four thousand Dollars, current money, conditioned for the due performance of the trust reposed in him as guardian to the said Orphan; which Bond was approved by the Court.
