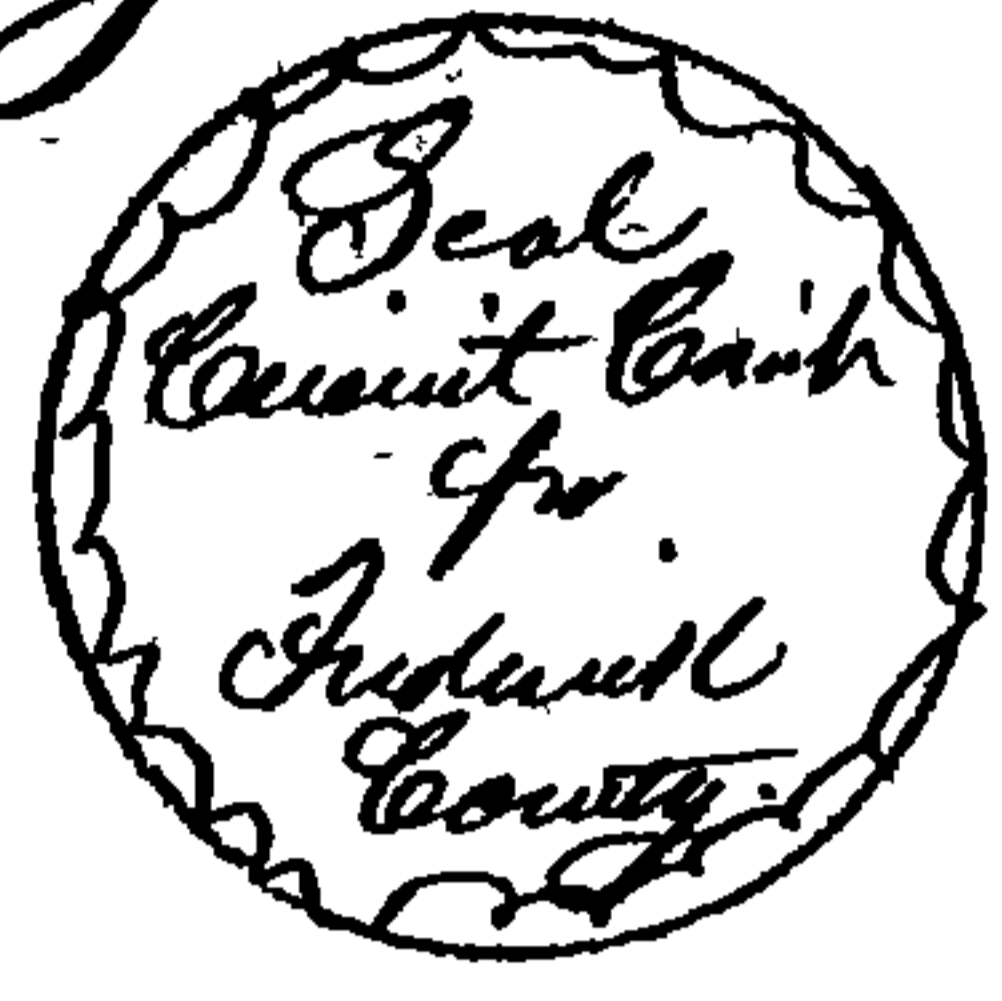


That the foregoing is a true copy of the Original deed as recorded in

In the name of God Amen - I Peter Crown of Frederick County, and  
State of Maryland, being weak in body, but of sound and disposing  
mind, memory and understanding considering the certainty of  
death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, and being desirous  
to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave  
this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore  
make and publish this my last will and testament in manner  
and form following, that is to say. - First and principally, I commit  
my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth,  
to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter  
named and after my debts and funeral charges are paid,  
I devise and bequeath as follows. - I give and bequeath  
unto my son Simon Peter the whole of my real and personal  
property of whatever kind, I may be possessed at the time of  
my death, to him the said Simon Peter, his heirs and assigns,  
in fee simple, after paying the following sums or legacies.  
I give and bequeath unto my son David the sum of two hundred  
dollars, to be paid him or his heirs by my son Simon Peter  
at the expiration of one year after my death. - I give and  
bequeath unto my son Ezra the sum of two hundred dollars  
to be paid to him or his heirs by my son Simon Peter, at the  
expiration of two years from the time of my death. - I give  
and bequeath unto the legal heirs of my son Joshua the sum  
of two hundred dollars, to be them or each of them that may  
be living at the time of my death, the said sum to be paid to  
them by my son Simon Peter at the expiration of three years  
after my death. - And I do further give and bequeath  
unto my daughter Mary Ann Miller, the sum of two hundred  
dollars to be paid to her, or her heirs by my said son Simon  
Peter at the expiration of four years after my death. - And  
lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son Simon Peter  
to be the sole Executor of this my last will and testament, re-  
voking and annulling all former wills by me, at any time her-  
etofore made, ratifying and confirming this and none other, to be  
my last will and testament.
