Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said John Miller and Sarah his wife, for and in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Five Dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Peter Craven, before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said John Miller and Sarah his wife, do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed, confirmed by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said Peter Craven his heirs and assigns all that piece part or parcel of land being part of a tract of land called "The Resurvey on Ramsburg's Chance" aforesaid, or by whatever name it may have been called - Beginning at a stone formerly set up at the end of the 2^d line of said Miller's Deed from Bean S. Pigman for 169 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres and 28 square perches of land, and running thence South 64 $^{\circ}$ 8' East 75 $\frac{1}{10}$ fms. to a stone now set up, South 19 $^{\circ}$ West 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ fms. to a stone set up for the end of the 3^d line of said Miller's Deed from said Pigman, thence with said 3^d line reversed to the beginning containing 2 acres and 3 square perches of land more or less. Together with all and singular, the improvements, woods, ways, waters, water-courses and appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and all the Estate, right, title and property interest, claim and demand whatsoever of them the said John Miller and Sarah his wife, both at law and in Equity of in to and out of the said piece part or parcel of land and premises hereby bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land so as aforesaid described, together with the appurtenances, and all and singular other the premises hereby bargained and sold unto him the said Peter Craven his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Peter Craven his heirs and assigns forever, and they the said John Miller and Sarah his wife, for themselves their heirs, Executors and administrators, do hereby covenant, grant, promise and agree to and with the said Peter Craven his heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, that they the said John Miller and Sarah his wife and their heirs, the said herein described piece part or parcel of land and premises hereby bargained and sold, with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Peter Craven his heirs and assigns against them the said John Miller and Sarah his wife, and their heirs, and against every other person or persons whatsoever - claiming or to claim any right, title or interest in and to the same or any part thereof by force
