The object of the Bill filed in this cause is to obtain a decree for the sale of all the real estate situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, whereof Simon Peter Craven late of said County, State of Maryland, died seized and possessed, and the distribution of the proceeds of sale among his heirs at law after deducting from the lands devised by the will of Simon Craven deceased to Simon Peter Craven, the legacies charged thereon by the will of said Simon Craven deceased. The Bill states that Simon Peter Craven died intestate on or about the thirteenth day of November in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy three, seized and possessed in fee of all those parts or tracts of Land situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, described in said bill and the exhibits accompanying the same, which lands and tenements descend to his heirs at law named and described in said bill, to wit - Lewis J. Craven David J. Craven, Margaret now wife of Carlton Oland, Caroline, now wife of Charles Oland, Mary Craven Cordelia now wife of William Wacker all adults, and Susan Craven Emma Craven, Howard Craven and Charles Craven all infants subject to the legacies charged by the will of said Simon Craven. The Bill states that Simon Peter Craven left a widow Susanna R. Craven entitled to dower in said real estate. The Bill further states that said Simon Craven by his will left to his children David Craven Ezra Craven Mary Ann Miller, and to the children and heirs of his son Joshua Craven deceased, named in said Bill, the sum of two hundred dollars each, which said legacies are a charge on the lands devised by said Simon Craven to the said Simon Peter Craven. The Bill further states, that the legacy of two hundred dollars, to David Craven has been paid, but no receipt or release given, that Dr. Thomas E. Miller has purchased the shares of George Craven, Charles Craven, Martin Craven, Thomas Craven, Joshua Craven, Richard R. Harper and Phoebe Harper his wife, children of Joshua Craven, and that
