This Deed made this thirty first day of May, in the year eighteen
hundred and seventy seven by us Salome Hoovis and Francis E. Hoovis
her husband of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland Witnesses
that (Whereas a certain Aloysius J. Omdorff has agreed to advance the
sum of Two Thousand and four Dollars and thirty two cents
for the purpose of paying off a Mortgage upon the real estate herein
after described which Mortgage is recorded in Liber C.M. No 7 folio
722 one of the Land Records of Frederick County, said Mortgage debt
having been abated to some extent by an order and decree filed in No. 3856
Equity in the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a court of Equity said
sum of money being the sum necessary to pay off said Mortgage debt as
now finally ascertained together with all interest thereon up to the date
of this deed and the costs for which said Salome Hoovis and husband
are liable in said No. 3856 Equity and in the Court of Appeals of Maryland
in the case aforesaid upon Appeal in said Court of Appeals and whereas said
Salome Hoovis and Francis E. Hoovis her husband are otherwise indebted
unto said Aloysius J. Omdorff in the sum of Fifty four dollars and
ninety cents. And whereas the said Grantors in this deed have agreed to
convey the property hereinafter described to said Aloysius J. Omdorff in
Trust as hereinafter set forth in order to fully secure the payment of said
sums of money with all interest due thereon and also for the purpose of
paying all debts due at the time of the Execution of this Deed by the said
Salome Hoovis to any other persons Now Therefore in consideration of the
premises We the said Salome Hoovis and Francis E. Hoovis her husband
do grant assign and transfer unto the said Aloysius J. Omdorff as
Trustee the following property namely all that real estate described in
a deed from John Hays and Eliza Clark his wife to said Salome Hoovis by
her then name of Salome Fox dated on the twelfth day of October in
the year eighteen hundred and seventy and filed in said case No. 3856
Equity in said Circuit Court for Frederick County which deed is to
be recorded simultaneously with this one of this deed it being also the same
real estate described in said Mortgage recorded in said Liber C.M. No 7
folio 722 as hereinbefore set forth and also all the personal property of
