It is therefore this 20th day of April Eighteen Hundred and Seventy eight by the circuit court for Frederick County sitting as a court of Equity ordered that the reasons and objections assigned by the said Salome Norris and Francis E Norris her husband why the said writ should not issue be and the same are hereby overruled as insufficient and it is further ordered that a peremptory writ of habere facias possessionem issue to the Sheriff of Frederick County commanding him to deliver forthwith to the said John Donohue the quiet possession of the real estate sold to him by the said A. F. Orendorff the Trustee in this cause and described in the proceedings and report of sale filed in this cause.
