

And your complainant further charges that if said deed does revoke said Will
 and that if said deed should be declared fraudulent, and void not only, as against
 creditors, but void to all intents and purposes, and the same as if it had never
 been executed and delivered, then, your complainants charge that the said
 Thomas Hammond did, intestate as to said lands in Frederick Carroll and
 Howard Counties leaving a sister Sulist, Angel Ann, Surviving and Louisa
 Griffith & Lydi Griffith her husband (Deftor) Hammond Burgess Hammond
 William Hammond Charlott Wood, who intermarried with Basil Wood,
 Richard Hammond Children of a deceased brother, of said Thomas Hammond
 And the Children of Regis Hammond a brother of said Thomas Hammond dec'd,
 who died before his said Brother, leaving said Children who resided in the
 State, of, Indiana and whose names are unknown to your complainants
 and to whom said lands descended as tenants in common. Your
 Complainants further charge that the Estate of said Thomas Hammond
 is largely involved in debt, that to pay, the said debts it will be necessary
 to, sell the whole of said lands free and unincumbered of any claim or
 demand of any, of the parties claiming an interest therein that the said
 devises mentioned in said Will are necessary, parties to said Bill, so that
 the interest of said parties may, be determined by your Honorable Court
 either as devises under said Will or as Estate for trust under said
 deed to Dawson V. Hammond. Your complainants further charge
 that the unknown heirs of said Thomas Hammond do not, reside
 in the State, of Maryland; - To the end therefore that the defendants
 hereinafter, named may answer the several matters and things stated
 in the foregoing, Bill of Complaint the same as if they, had been specially
 interrogated thereto, and that the deed from Thomas Hammond to said
 Dawson V. Hammond conveying all the lands of said Thomas Ham-
 mond lying, in the Counties of, Frederick Carroll and Howard Counties
 may be declared to be void and may, be vacated and set aside and that
 a decree may, be passed for a sale of the, same or such parts thereof, as
 may, be necessary, to pay, the debts of the said Thomas Hammond and
 that your complainants may, have such other, and further relief as,
 the, nature and Equity of their case may require. May it please your
 Honor, to grant unto, your complainants, an order of publication
 giving notice to the unknown heirs of said Thomas Hammond who
 are now residents as aforesaid of the Substance and object of this
 Court in person or by, Solicitor on or before a certain day, to answer
 the premises and show Cause if any, they have why, a decree ought
 not to pass as prayed. And also a writ of, Subpoena against the said
