At the Request of Burgess Hammond the following Deed was recorded Sept 3<sup>rd</sup> 1874  
This Deed made this third day of August in the Year of Our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Seventy four by Dawson V. Hammond and Ann M. Hammond his wife of the first part and Burgess Hammond of the second part. Witnesseth that Whereas Thomas Hammond did by Deed dated Jan the thirteenth 1874 convey to the said Dawson V. Hammond the hereinafter described premises in fee simple and Whereas by last will and Testament the said Thomas Hammond did devise the same aforesaid and hereinafter described premises to the said Burgess Hammond his heirs and assigns in fee forever. Now therefore in order to Execute the interests and purposes set forth in the said Will and also for the further consideration of the sum of five dollars in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Dawson V. Hammond and Ann M. Hammond his wife do give grant, convey in fee simple to the said Burgess Hammond all their right, title and interest which they may, may be possessed of or to, which they may in any manner be entitled in and to a certain tract of land and the appurtenances thereto it being the Farm on which the said Burgess Hammond and his family now reside lying in New Market, District Frederick County, Maryland containing about Seven Acres and three rods more or less To have and to hold the above described tract of land to the said Burgess Hammond his heirs and assigns forever.
