

That said Hammond's personal Estate, is largely insolvent, and that
 it will be necessary to sell the Real Estate, whereof he did seized and
 possessed, for the payment, of his debts. That Thos. Hammond was
 charged in said Original Bill made a deed of Certain Land situated
 in Frederick Carroll & Howard Counties to Dawson V. Hammond and
 that the said deed was fraudulent and Void as to the Creditors of
 said Hammond, that he also made a will as charged in said
 Original Bill wherein he devised to certain Legatees the lands
 situated in said Counties of Frederick Carroll & Howard Counties and
 Elsewhere and that the deed aforesaid being Executed subsequent to
 said Will was a revocation pro tanto - That certain Persons (viz
 R. H. Marshall, Thomas Kellogg, and Ellen Nelson respectively) had
 Mortgages on the property conveyed by said Deed to Dawson V.
 Hammond and that the same were liens thereon for the Mortgage
 debts, intended to be secured thereby, and that certain Persons
 named in said Bill were the heirs at law of said Thomas Hammond.
 This amended Bill of Complaint of said John Hardt and William
 M. Keefer partners trading as Hardt and Keefer in behalf of
 themselves and all other creditors of the said Thomas Hammond
 who may come in and contribute to the Expenses of this Bill charges
 that in addition to the Parties named in said Bill of Complaint as heirs
 at law of said Thomas Hammond dec'd. That the said Thomas Hammond
 also left as his heirs at law Nathan Hammond and Carroll Hammond children
 of a deceased Brother, whose residences are unknown to said complainant, and the
 Children of John Hammond now deceased a Brother, of said Thomas Hammond
 whose names and residences are unknown to said complainant, that said defendants
 do not reside in the State of Maryland. - To them therefore that the defendants named in the
 Original Bill of Complaint and the defendants named in the amended Bill of Complaint may
 answer the matters and things charged in said Original and amended Bills
 and that the aforesaid to said Dawson V. Hammond may be executed
 and set aside - and the Real Estate in the proceedings mentioned may be
 sold for the payment of the debts of the said Thomas Hammond and that
 the complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature
 and Equity of their Cause may require May it please Your Honor to
 grant unto your complainants an order of publication giving notice to
 the said non resident defendants the substance and object of the
 Original and amended Bills of Complaint and warning them to
 appear in person or by solicitor in this Court on or before the day named
 in said order and shew Cause if any they have why a decree ought
 not to pass as prayed & as in duty lie
