

2^d Q. Int. Do you know who paid the taxes on the property?
 Answer: I don't know of my own knowledge only, what Uncle Tom, said "That Burgess was paying his own taxes on his own farm."

3^d Q. Int. Do you know in whom the legal title to the property was for or to June 13th 1874?

Answer: I don't know in whom the legal title was.

4th Q. Int. Do you know if Col. Hammond claimed the property as his and did he by his Will, devise the property to any one?
 And, if yes, to whom?

Answer: Yes he did when he made his will he left it to Burgess in the Will

Whereupon there being, no other witnesses present to be examined and further time being required for the production of evidence the said Commission was adjourned to the 14th day of June A. D. 1877, at which time and at the place aforesaid, I, the said, and there proceeded to take the following testimony, to wit:

Elias L. Debachmutt, a witness of lawful age produced upon the part of Burgess Hammond Defendant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioner by the Defendant, and herewith, returned deposes and says,

To the 1st Q. Int. Were you acquainted with Col. Thomas Hammond in his lifetime? If yes how long, did you know him?

Answer: - I was for thirty (30) years for a great many years,

2^d Q. Int. Do you recollect an occasion of selling any real estate to (except to) Burgess Hammond? If yes, state the transaction when it was who bargained for the same and what was said if anything by Col. Hammond during the transaction?

Answer: - I really can't tell the time. I've seen a good many (except to) years ago. I sold Burgess Hammond two Wood lots, near his farm. They contained twenty acres of land altogether. I think I got somewhere in the neighborhood of 300\$ for both. Col. Thomas Hammond paid for them, and told me they were for Burgess Hammond's farm.

To the 1st Q. Int. Were you acquainted with Col. Hammond in his life time? If yes how long?

Answer I knew him for thirty years.

2^d Q. Int. Are you acquainted with Burgess Hammond?

Answer: Yes Sir.
