

11th Q Int: Do you remember any other specific occasions than you have mentioned?

12th Q Int: when was your sister there what was her name, and what was said?

Answer: My sister been about eighteen years ago Her name was Helen Mary McKee. He said it it was Burgess place he gave it to him.

13th Q Int: Did you not say, that Col. Hammond in 1852 said to Burgess to go on and improve and he Col. Hammond would pay for them?

Answer: Certainly I said it.

14th Q Int: Did Col. Hammond pay for the improvements?

Answer: For the house some and for the other improvements some & Burgess paid part.

15th Q Int: what part did Col. Hammond pay for and what part Burgess?

Answer: Uncle paid for part of the house and Burgess paid for part of it for he had improved the house since Uncle Tom's death.

16th Q Int: Who paid for the barn and fencing?

Answer: Burgess paid for all the fencing & found a great part of the timber for the barn.

17th Q Int: who furnished the balance for the barn?

Answer: Uncle Tom.

18th Q Int: Did not Col. Hammond pay for some of the rails that made up the fence?

Answer: I think he did.

19th Q Int: If you think Col. Hammond paid for some of the rails why did you say in answer to the 16th cross interrogatory, that Burgess paid for all the fencing?

Answer: All the post and rail fencing was all paid for by Burgess I thought you were speaking of that, I didn't know you meant the other.

20th Q Int: If you don't know about the fencing on the land how do you know Col. Hammond didn't pay for any post and rail fence?

Answer: Because I know Burgess paid for it because I helped to pay for it - my money paid for it.

21st Q Int: Did you ever hear Burgess ask for a deed for the land?

Answer: No Sir I never heard ask for a deed for it in my life.

22nd Q Int: Did you ever hear Col. Hammond say anything about giving a deed for it?

Answer: No Sir I never heard anything about the deed at all.
