Bill of  
Complaint

The Bill of Complaint of Bernard C. Rothkhalfer and Mary Ellen  
Rothkhalfer his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland and Jacob  
Boyer and Elizabeth. Boyer his wife of Washington County, State of  
Maryland respectfully shew to your Honors that they are seized in fee of  
two undivided thirds of a tract or parcel of land lying in said County  
conveyed to the said Mary Ellen Rothkhalfer formerly, M. Bowie and  
the said Elizabeth. Boyer formerly, M. Bowie by Martin M. Bowie and  
Elizabeth M. Bowie his wife; and that the other, undivided third of said  
Land is held by one Elizabeth. M. Bowie of Frederick County, Maryland  
all of which will appear by reference to a certified copy of a deed herewith  
exhibited marked Exhibit No 1. which your complainants pray together  
with all other Exhibits herein after produced may be taken and examined  
as part of this their Bill of Complaint the same as if set forth in  
words and figures. Your complainants further state that the said  
Land is not susceptible of partition among the parties interested with-  
out loss or injury and that it will be to the interest and advantage of  
all the parties interested that the Real estate, in the proceedings  
mentioned be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court and the  
proceeds of sale divided among those interested according to their  
respective interests. — And your complainants further state, that  
the said Elizabeth. M. Bowie will not agree that the said premises  
should be sold, and is unwilling to join with the complainants in  
enjoining the same. To the end therefore that the defendant, Elizabeth. M.  
Bowie, may answer the matters and things herein before stated and that  
the Real Estate, in the proceedings mentioned be sold under a decree of  
your Honorable Court and the proceeds of sale divided among those  
interested according to their Respective Rights and that your complainants  
may have such further and other relief as the nature and Equity of  
their case may require. May it please your Honors to grant unto your  
Complainants the writ of Subpoena against the said Elizabeth. M. Bowie

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
