2^d Interrogatory: When did you call on Isaac Thomas Devilbiss demand payment of said Mortgage?

Answer: - Sometime after it came into my hands it was some time in my hands before I called upon him.

3^d Interrogatory: Did you call on any other of the Defendants and request payment?

Answer: No, Sir: I don't know as I did - Kemp said he had nothing to do with it.

4th Interrogatory: Was the said Isaac Thomas Devilbiss the Mortgagor?

Answer: No he was not.

5th Interrogatory: Why did you call on him?

Answer: Because he was the only one I know to call upon the balance wouldnt interfere with it in any way.

6th Interrogatory: Did you ever call on Mrs Maria Devilbiss and request payment?

Answer: I did not Sir.

7th Interrogatory: What do you say to Isaac Thomas Devilbiss about the mortgage when you called on him?

Answer: I asked him frequently when they were going to pay it He said they were going to pay it as soon as they could get the money.

8th Interrogatory: Did you specify the Amount?

Answer: Yes Sir he knew the amount I shew it to him.
