

Seventy five cents (\$<sup>75</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) costs heretofore which was recovered against me & Daniel & being his security, I have a note of Daniels for \$99.36 heretofore. The \$50 paid to his sister was paid in July, 1876, on a note for \$115. to Thomas Kennerford (heretofore).

Defendants heretofore filed with the Commissioners as evidence "Exhibits Nos. 2 & 3" M. B. which are herewith returned by the said Commissioner 14<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: As Daniel yet indebted to you for these

Sums of Money?

Answer: They have never been settled.

15<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: Was there any agreement made between you and Daniel or his wife in reference to those sums of money being credited on the Mortgage of J. J. J. for what?

Answer: No Sir we never said a word about it.

16<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: Did you at the time you gave the Mortgage for \$400. know what the amount of costs were on the debt mentioned by you? If you had did you know it?

Answer: I didn't know any more than what Daniel & Frank Beugle told me they told me they had borrowed \$172. from Alexander Beugle and I thought the whole costs were included in Dan's Mortgage

17<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: What representations were made when you executed the Beugle Mortgage and by whom?

Answer: Nothing at all except that they had borrowed that much. It was to pay the costs they said and Mr Beugle he read it in the Mortgage and said "that's what it was for: Mr Francis Beugle said that Dan hadn't money enough and had to borrow from Alexander Beugle to make it up that the lawyers were after the money.

18<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: (Excepted to)

Would you have executed the Mortgage to Daniel for \$400 - if you had known that it did not require that amount to pay off said costs?

Answer: No I would not.

19<sup>th</sup> Interrogatory: Were you indebted to Daniel or his wife for any other sum than the amount of costs he paid for you in the Equity case?

Answer: No I am not.

1<sup>st</sup> Interrogatory: If Daniel owed you the \$60.35. you say you paid Simmons for him and the note
