Israel Wilkin }
At the request of Israel Wilkin the following Deed is Rendered May 23^d 1857. This indenture, made this twenty eighth day of December, in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty seven, between David M. Good and Mary M. Good, his wife, of Washington County, in the State of Maryland, of the one part and Israel Wilkin of Frederick County, and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth, that the said David M. Good and Mary M. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and twenty five dollars, lawful money of the United State to them in hand well and truly paid by the said Israel Wilkin at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said Israel Wilkin and to his heirs and assigns, all the following described tracts or parcels of land called Fox Range, lying and being situate in the South Mountain in Frederick County, and State aforesaid adjoining the lands of Jacob Harbaugh, David Pilem, and Elias Harbaugh, the same being part of that tract of Lands heretofore conveyed to the said David M. Good by a certain Abraham Stone and Susannah, his wife, by deed bearing date February twenty fifth Eighteen hundred and forty one, recorded in Liber N. E. No. 13, folios 155, 156, 157 & 158, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and State aforesaid. The said tract or parcel of land as above described being bounded as follows, viz: Beginning at a Spanish Oak tree, adjoining lands of David Pilem and running thence South sixty six degrees East thirty two perches to a white oak, thence North twenty and a half degrees East,
