At the request of Israel Willian  
the following Deed was recorded April 15, 1872

Israel Willian  
eight hundred and seventy two, by William H. Gladhill and  
Ann Matilda Gladhill, his wife, of Frederick County and State  
of Maryland, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the  
sum of Twenty Dollars, the said William H. Gladhill and Ann  
Matilda Gladhill, his wife, do grant unto Israel Willian of the  
County of Frederick and State of Maryland, his heirs and as-  
signs, in fee simple, part of Tract of land being part of a  
Tract conveyed by James Gladhill and Catharine Gladhill, his  
wife, to said William H. Gladhill, said deed dated April 30th.  
A. D. 1859, lying and being situated in Frederick County, and State  
of Maryland, - Beginning for said part to be hereby conveyed  
at a rock on the Twenty third or closing line of a Deed by John  
W. Coon, Executor of Jacob Harbaugh, deceased, to Israel Will-  
ian, running thence South 47 1/2 degrees West Eighteen Rods,  
thence with land of Israel Willian North 37 degrees West thirteen  
Poles to a corner between lands of said Wm. H. Gladhill and  
said Israel Willian, thence with land of said Willian, North 86 1/2  
East to place of beginning, containing One hundred and  
Sixteen Poles of land be the same more or less, Together  
with all the buildings and improvements thereon, and of every  
the rights, roads, ways, waters, privileges, appurtenances and ad-  
vantages to the same or in any wise appertaining. And the said  
William H. Gladhill and Ann Matilda Gladhill, his wife, do  
hereby further covenant that they will warrant generally the  
property hereby granted, and that they execute such further as-  
surances as may be requisite and necessary
