The Joint and separate answer of Lavinia Willian, widow of Israel Willian, of David J. Willian and Catharine Willian his wife, Cornelius A. Willian and Harriet Willian, his wife, Ann Margaret Willian, Mary A. Moorhead and Samuel A. Moorhead, her husband, and James Calvin Willian of Frederick County, State of Maryland, to the Bill of Complaint of Samuel Willian and Sabilla Willian, his wife, of the State of Illinois, of George W. Willian and Malinda E. Willian his wife, of the State of Illinois, of Jacob Willian and Sarah A. Willian, his wife, of the Territory of Idaho, and of John S. Willian of the State of Illinois, filed in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in Equity.

These Defendants admit that Israel Willian late of Frederick County, deceased, had seized and purchased of all three pieces or parcels of land situate in Frederick County, State of Maryland, described in the Exhibits filed in this cause containing about ninety three acres of land more or less. They further admit that said Israel Willian left a widow Lavinia Willian entitled to dower in said premises, and the following children, all adults and residents of the States, Territory and Counties, and married as stated in said bill as his heirs at law, to wit: 1 Samuel Willian, 2. Orpah Willian, 3. George W. Willian, 4. John S. Willian, 5. David J. Willian, 6. Cornelius A. Willian, 7. Ann Margaret Willian, 8. Mary Ann, now wife of Samuel Moorhead, 9 James Calvin Willian. -

These Defendants further admit that said lands are not susceptible of division without loss or injury to the party concerned, and that the interest of all parties interested, require that the said lands should be sold, and the proceeds of distributed under the order of this Court. The Defendant Lavinia Willian, widow, consents and agrees that, the said lands should be sold for of her dower upon receiving in full thereof her due proportion of the purchase money, and the other Defendants consent and agree that a decree may be passed as prayed.
