 It is this 30<sup>th</sup> day of December, in the year 1878, by the Circuit Court  
 for Frederick County ordered that the proceeds of sale of the real estate  
 of Israel Willian Dec<sup>d</sup> be applied to the satisfaction of the debts of said  
 Israel Willian unless good cause to the contrary be shown on or before the  
 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1879, Provided that a copy of this order with a  
 copy of said Petition be served on Lavinia Willian, David J. Willian  
 Cornelius A. Willian Ann Margaret Willian, Samuel Moorehead &  
 Mary Ann Moorehead his wife, John Labron Willian and Lewis Craw-  
 ford Administrator of Israel Willian Dec<sup>d</sup> Defendants residing in  
 Frederick County, by the Sheriff of Frederick County, on or before the 3<sup>d</sup>  
 day of February 1879, and provide the Petitioner give notice to Samuel  
 Willian Israel Willian, George H. Willian and John J. Willian the absent  
 Defendants of the object and substance of this Petition by Publication in some  
 Newspaper published in Frederick County for four successive weeks prior to the  
 third day of February next warning them to be and appear in this Court on or before

 to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County for at least

 said Israel Willian Dec<sup>d</sup> to file their claims duly authenticated with the  
 Clerk of this Court on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1879, otherwise they may  
 be debarred
