In the matter of the Petition of the Frederick Town Savings Institution
in behalf of itself and other creditors of Israel Willian late of Frederick
County, Deceased,

The object of this Petition is to have the Proceeds of the sale of certain lands
belonging to the Estate of Israel Willian late of Frederick County
& related applied in Payment and satisfaction of his debts the personal
Estate being insufficient,

The Petition states that the said Israel Willian was indebted to The
Frederick Town Savings Institution, and is still indebted to the amount
of six Hundred and Sixty one Dollars and forty six cents with interest.

That Samuel Willian and wife and others filed their Bill in Equity for
the sale of the Real Estate of which the said Israel Willian died seized &
possessed, and that by a decree of the Court passed in No. 4061 Equity
in the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity, Lewis Compher
was appointed Trustee to make sale of said Real Estate and has sold the
same for the sum of Thirteen Hundred and seventy two Dollars & Eighty
two Cents, that the Personal Estate of said Israel Willian is wholly in-
sufficient for the Payment of his debts, and that the Petitioners and the
other creditors of said Israel Willian are entitled to have their claims
paid out of the proceeds of said sale.

That Israel Willian died intestate in the month of December 1873,
leaving a widow named Sarina Willian and the following children
surviving, to whom the lands mentioned in said Decree de-
scended and who are entitled to the proceeds of sale in & out to the claims
of the creditors of said Israel Willian Deceased as follows, Samuel Willian
Josiah Willian George W. Willian John S. Willian David S. Willian Cor-
nelius Willian Ann Margaret Willian, Mary Ann Monhead and John
Calvin Willian.

That Samuel Willian, Josiah Willian, George W. Willian and John S.
Willian, are now residents of the State of Maryland, and are of full
age

It is thereupon this 30th day of December 1878, by the Circuit Court
for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity, ordered, that the
