This deed made this nineteenth day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy three by us Greenbury Staunton and Mary M. Staunton his wife. Dit respect that in consideration of fifty dollars (\$50) we the said Greenbury Staunton and Mary M. Staunton his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland do grant unto John W. England of said County and State all that Tract or parts of Tracts of Land lying, situate and being in Mount Pleasant District Frederick County, State of Maryland, the same being part of "Middle Plantation" Beginning at a certain point Eighty and one half degrees East, forty one perches and eleven links from a stone at the end of Eighty two perches on the fifth line of part of a Tract of Land called "Middle Plantation" and running from a Hickory tree South Eighty and one half degrees East two and six tenths perches, South three and one one half degrees East, nine and thirty five one hundred perches, North, eighty seven and one one half degrees West, two and fifteen one hundredths perches, South six degrees and nine perches to the Beginning, containing Twenty square perches of Land, it being the same parcel of Land that was conveyed to Capt. Andrew Thomson by Deed dated December Seventh A.D. 1839, and Recorded in Liber A.S. No. 10 Folios 251 & 252, one of the land records of Frederick County State of Maryland, referred heretofore had well known fully and at large appear.
