In the name of God Amen. I John McDonald, of Prince Georges County, Maryland, being weak of body, but of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, considering the the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of the time thereof and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, and thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore make and publish this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say: First and principally, I commit my soul into the hands of Almighty God, and my body to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executor hereinafter named, and after all my debts and funeral expenses are fully paid, I give, devise and bequeath as follows, viz: Three hundred dollars to the three children of my late wife's sister Catharine Stegins, viz: Susan Stegins, John Stegins, and their sister Mary, to be equally divided among them, One hundred dollars to each. Twelve hundred dollars to my six nephews and nieces as follows: - To Mary Ann Biggs, wife of John A. Biggs, William Biggs, James Biggs, Catharine wife of John Lambrecht, Rebecca wife of Jacob Keefe and Elizabeth wife of Eli Poole, to be equally divided among them Two hundred dollars each. I direct my Executor to pay all taxes and charges to which the above legacies are liable, so that each legatee receives the full amount hereunto bequeathed to him or her - And also direct that these legacies be paid within two years after my death. I direct my executor to place a tomb stone over my grave. All the rest and residue of my estate real, personal or mixed, I give, devise and bequeath to my nephew John W. Miller his heirs and assigns forever.
