

consisting in one lot of ground (number five laid out as an additional lot to Redbank Town, in Redbank County, then occupied by the said Christian Agnew deceased, - And whereas, the said John Jacob Agnew since the death of his father and before the year seven hundred and eighty six died intestate and leaving no issue at the time of his decease whereby the part bequeathed to him the said John Jacob Agnew deceased, to the said Christian Agnew his brother - Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that the said Christian Agnew for, and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid before the executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Christian Agnew doth hereby acknowledge hath given granted, bargained and sold, released and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, release and confirm unto the said John McDonald, his heirs and assigns all his, the said Christian Agnew's right and title of his and to the above mentioned lot of ground and personal estate as bequeathed to him by the will of his father aforesaid - Also all his right and title of his and to the part of said lot of ground that descended to him by the decease of his brother John Jacob Agnew - Also his proportion of said John Jacob Agnew's part of his said father's personal estate To have and to hold the within recited parts or proportions of the said lot of ground unto him the said John McDonald his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said John McDonald, his heirs and assigns forever, and for no other use, intent or purpose whatsoever. And the said Christian Agnew doth hereby, for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators, covenant, promise, grant and agree to and with the said John McDonald, his heirs and assigns to warrant and defend to him the said John McDonald, his heirs and assigns, the parts of lots or proportions of ground and premises herein before described against all persons claiming or to claim under the said Christian Agnew his heirs or assigns.
