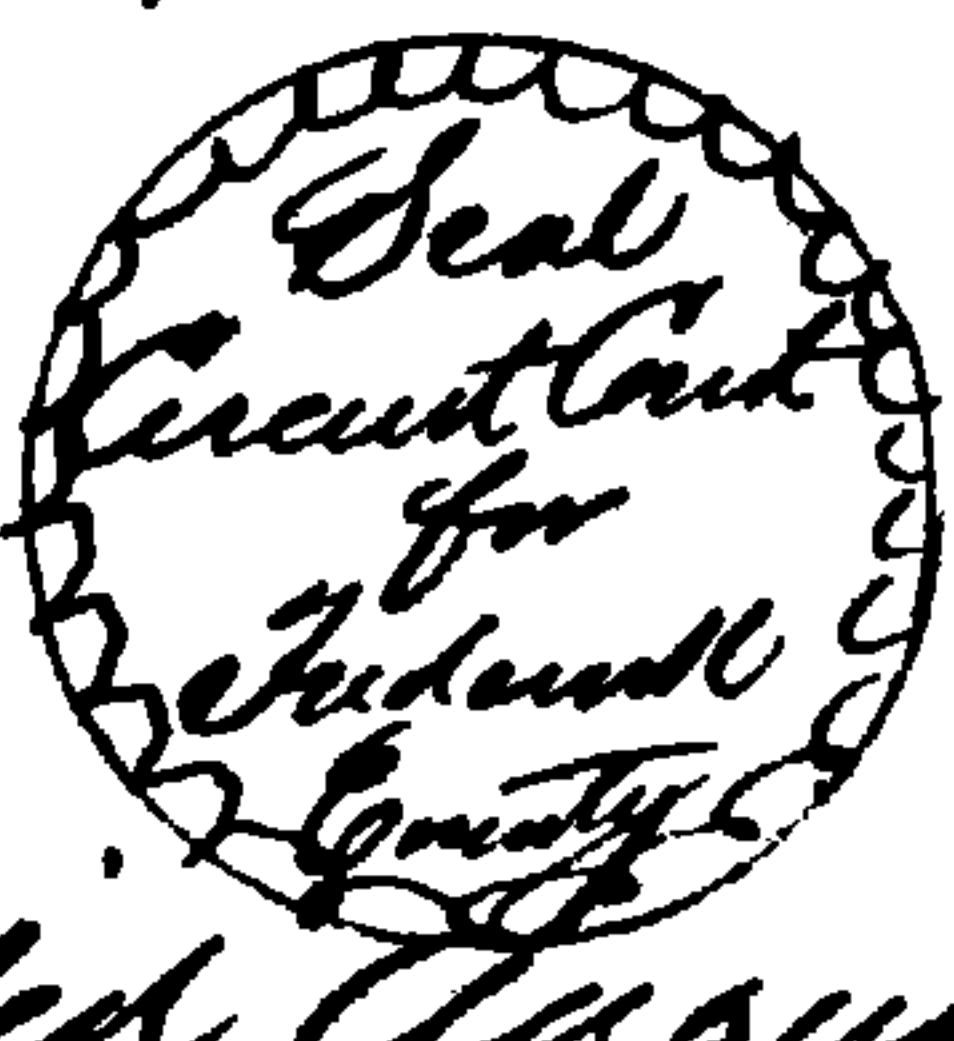

At the request of John M. Donald the following
 Deed is recorded 28th. December 1814, to wit:

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of December,
 in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and fourteen, between
 Margaret Griffith, widow of Richard Griffith, late of Frederick
 County, deceased, of the one part, and John M. Donald
 of the Town, County and State aforesaid, of the other part -
 Whereas Henry Camhart by deed bearing date the twenty fourth
 day of August, in the year of Our Lord seventeen hundred and
 ninety two, did sell and convey unto Richard Griffith, all that
 part of a Lot or portion of ground, situate, lying and being in
 Frederick Town, Frederick County, aforesaid, known and distinguis-
 ed by number One hundred and two, reference being had
 to said deed recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County, will
 more fully and at large appear: And Whereas, the said Richard
 Griffith by his last will and testament, bearing date the eleventh
 day of September, eighteen hundred and five, among other things
 did devise and bequeath unto his said wife, Margaret Griffith,
 all the above described part of a Lot or portion of ground for-
 ever, reference being had to said will recorded in the Register
 Office, for Frederick County will appear. And whereas, since the
 execution of said will it hath been discovered that the said Rich-
 ard Griffith was not naturalized agreeable to the laws of
 this State at the time of the execution of the above recited conveyance
 to him, therefore, the title to the above recited part of a Lot or portion
 of ground did not vest in him the said Richard Griffith, or
 his said wife Margaret, under said will. And Whereas, the
 said Margaret Griffith by her petition preferred to the General
 Assembly of Maryland, December Session, eighteen hundred and
 thirteen, praying that the title of the above recited part of the
 Lot or portion of ground might vest in her agreeable to the
 intention of the said Testator's will, which title was accordingly
 vested and confirmed in the said Margaret Griffith her heirs
 and assigns forever, by virtue of an act of Assembly
 passed said session in her favor Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said Margaret Griffith, for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of One hundred dollars, current money to
 her in hand paid, the receipt whereof the said Margaret Griffith
 doth hereby acknowledge hath given, granted, bargained, and
 sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain, and sell
