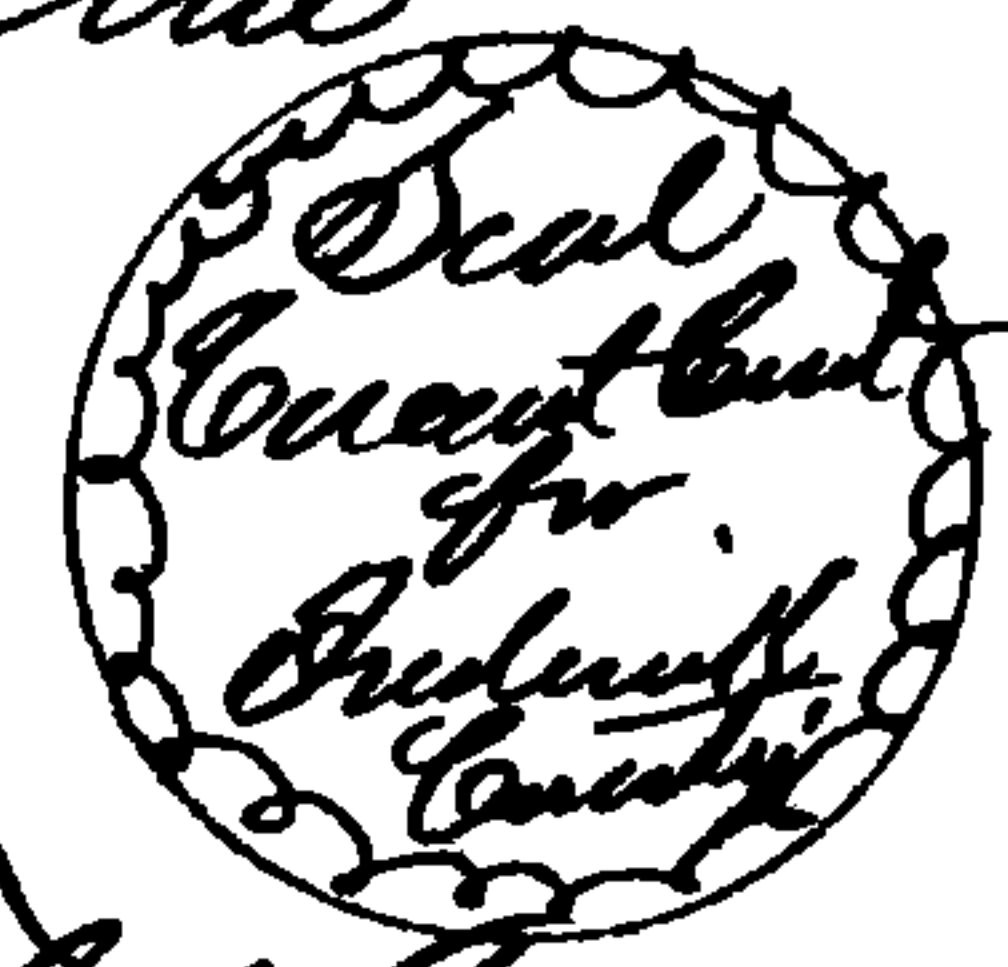

At the request of Geo. M^r. Donald the following Deed was Recorded 23rd August 1803.

This Indenture, made the twentieth day of August, in the year of our Lord 1803, between Henry Minneller of Frederick Town, in Frederick County and State of Maryland, of the one part, and John M^r. Donald of the same town, County and State aforesaid, of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Henry Minneller for and on consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds current money, to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien transfer and make over unto him the said John M^r. Donald, his heirs and assigns forever, One fourth part of a lot of ground situate, lying and being in Frederick Town, in the County and State aforesaid conveyed by a certain Peter Gibhart to the said Henry Minneller by deed bearing date the 25th. day of April 1796, and beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the North West corner of said lot, and running East with with the street to the centre or middle of said lot, then running Southwardly till it intersects Joseph Doll's
