- 1st. Are you acquainted with the parties to this suit, and if you how long have you known them and each of them.
2. Were you acquainted with a certain Ann Catharine Miller formerly a resident of Frederick County, if you, is she dead or alive, when and where did she die?
3. Did the said Ann C. Miller leave children, and if you, state their names and places of residence, and if any are married to whom.
4. Did the said Ann C. Miller die testate or intestate?
5. Are you acquainted with the lands that the said Ann C. Miller, died seized and possessed, if you, look at the Exhibits now shown you, marked Exhibit No. 1 to 11, inclusive. Can said lands be divided amongst the parties interested without loss and injury, state your reasons for your opinion.
6. Was the said Ann C. Miller interested in any other land in Frederick County, other than the land described in the Exhibits referred to in your previous answer?
7. How long have you and the said William Kolb and Ann C. Miller been in possession of said lot?
8. Who has received the rents and profits, and paid taxes on said lot of ground, and for how many years?
9. Can said lot be divided without loss and injury to the parties, and if no state your reasons for your opinion.
10. You say the land belongs to the heirs of Mrs. Ann C. Miller and yourself, what interest has said Mr. Kolb now in the said lot.
11. Would or would it not be to the interest and advantage of all concerned, that the lands mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and the proceeds distributed amongst the parties interested in it if you, state your reasons for the same.
