were by the Court read and considered - It is thereupon, this 17th.
day of January, in the year Eighteen hundred and seventy seven
of the Circuit Court for Fredrick County, as a Court of Equity, and
by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered and decreed, that
the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold,
and that David S. H. Miller of Baltimore City, and Jacob H. Miller
of Fredrick County, be, and they are hereby appointed Trustees to make
the said sales, and that the course and manner of their pro-
ceeding shall be as follows They shall first file in the Clerk's
Office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed
