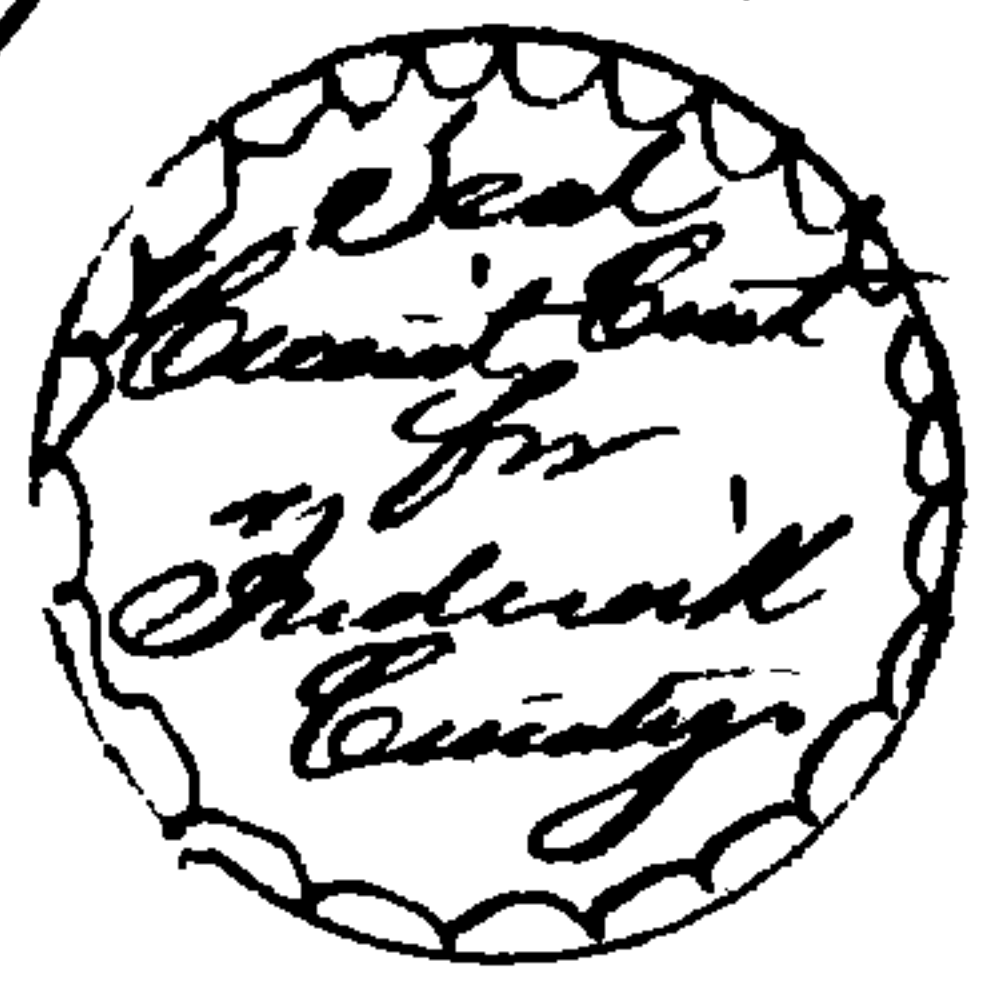


Maryland, Oct: The State of Maryland
