 ed by deed by Thomas H. Claggett and others to a certain Lewis A.
 Eastwood, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part of this Bill
 marked Exhibit No. 6; and excepting so much thereof as was conveyed
 by Thomas H. Claggett and others to a certain William Bailey by
 deed a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part of this Bill
 marked Exhibit No. 7; and excepting so much thereof as was
 conveyed by Thomas H. Claggett and wife, to Luigan Boteter
 and others by deed, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed
 as part of this Bill marked Exhibit No. 8; and also excepting
 so much thereof as was conveyed by Thomas H. Claggett and
 wife, to a certain Samuel Claggett by deed, a certified copy whereof
 is herewith filed as part of this Bill, marked Exhibit No. 9; and
 for greater certainty of description your Complainants also file
 herewith as part of this Bill a Surveyor's Certificate marked Exhibit
 No. 10, the real estate of which said Thomas H. Claggett did seize
 and possessed being those described by course and distanced as
 Lots Numbers two and three respectively in said Surveyor's Certificate.
 Your Complainants further state that said Thomas H. Claggett by his
 last will and testament left his property including said real estate
 to his widow your Complainant Latta Claggett and to his four children
 in equal shares as tenants in common each being entitled to one un-
 divided fifth part thereof, said children being Henry O. Claggett who
 is married, and the name of whose wife is Jamie Claggett, William
 B. Claggett, Julia H. Rogus who is now the wife of Alexander H.
 Rogus, and Thomas H. Claggett who is married, and the name
 of whose wife is Harriet H. Claggett, all of whom are adults,
 living in the State of Virginia, and Complainants in this Bill, and
 your Complainants file herewith as part of this Bill a certified
 copy of said last will and testament marked Exhibit No. 11,
 and that said parties are the legal heirs, at-law of said Thomas
 H. Claggett, deceased, and his only heirs-at-law Your Complain-
 ants further state that a certain Richard S. Douglas and Henry
 C. Sellman, partners trading as Douglas & Sellman have obtained
 judgment in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, for the sum of one
 thousand Eight hundred and ninety-nine dollars and Eighteen
 cents, with interest from the sixth day of March A.D. 1878, till
 paid, and nine dollars and fifty five cents costs against your
 Complainant Thomas H. Claggett and have attached his interest
 in said real estate and obtained judgment of condemnation
 thereon for said sum of money, and eight dollars and
