 This Deed, made this 24th. day of January, in the year
 One thousand eight hundred and sixty eight, by Thomas
 H. Clagett and Lala Clagett his wife, Witnesses, that in
 consideration of Two thousand four hundred dollars, we the
 said Thomas H. Clagett and Lala Clagett, his wife, do grant
 in fee simple, unto Samuel Clagett all of the following des-
 cribed piece or parcel of land lying and being in Fred-
 erick County, and State of Maryland, it being a part of a
 tract of land called "Tilleda," or bet a part or parts of
 any other tracts or tracts whatsoever. Beginning for the
 same at the beginning of the farm lately purchased of
 Thomas H. Clagett by William H. Botler, it being also
 the end of the third line of the deed dated December 31st. 1841.
 from Henry Clagett and Althea to Joseph Cartzendafer for
 41 acres, two rods and 13 perches of land, and running
 thence with the lines of said deed nine courses, commencing the
 same for variation, North 16 3/4 degrees West 17 perches,
 North 24 1/2 degrees East 3 7/10 perches, South 57 degrees West 22
 perches, South 38 degrees West 14 perches, South 50 1/4 degrees
 West 8 perches, South 59 1/4 degrees West 10 perches, South 50 1/2
 degrees West 16 perches, South 61 1/2 degrees West 18 perches South
 50 1/2 degrees West 4 4/10 perches to meet the end of the second
 line of William Bailey's lot and with the third line thereof,
 South 11 1/2 degrees East 33 44/100 perches to a stone at the end of
