

1st All my debts to be paid.

2nd Having made advances to all my children except my son William B. Clagett to the amount of Three Thousand Dollars out of their interest in their Mother's Estate, to equalize, I hereby direct that the sum of Three Thousand Dollars be paid to the said William B. Clagett.

3rd The Bond of Three Thousand Dollars now among my Bonds, executed by A. H. Rogers is hereby cancelled give to me in consideration of the Three Thousand Dollars just alluded.

4th My advances to my son Henry A. Clagett on the same account have exceeded the sum of Three Thousand Dollars, but in consequence of the heavy loss sustained by him in the destruction of the Big Spring I reduce the amount to the sum of Three Thousand Dollars to put him on an equality with my other children and here I wish most unequivocally to declare that this arrangement is entirely my own act, entirely without his knowledge.

5th After the payment of the Three Thousand Dollars, to Wm. B. Clagett and the payment of all my debts, I desire the residue of my estate to be equally divided between my beloved wife, Fella Clagett & my dear children. In appointing the different quotas, should Julia H. Rogers prefer her share in the Woodburn Farm, it is my wish that she shall be gratified also in appointing my wife's quota, I wish such Bonds as I have secured by deed of trust or mortgage on land be set apart for her. I shall make no selection of Executors or Administrators, but leave the matter open to my children that they may arrange the matter to suit themselves, but desire the Court to grant letters of Administrator to such as may be agreed upon among themselves without demanding security from them.
