Baker, all their interest in part of "Stambaugh", part of "Stoney Level", part of "Catey's memorandum", part of "Long Road", and all of "Spike Betweens", lying and being in the County of Frederick, and State of Maryland, which was conveyed to Jacob Zentmyer of the County of Frederick and State of Maryland, by deed from Samuel M. Hill, Christian Shoup and Joseph Shell and descended from him by will to Sarah Creager, Mary A. Harp, Jacob Zentmyer, Nancy Kline, Elizabeth Baker and Barbara E. Smith, containing One hundred and sixty four acres more or less, in full script.
