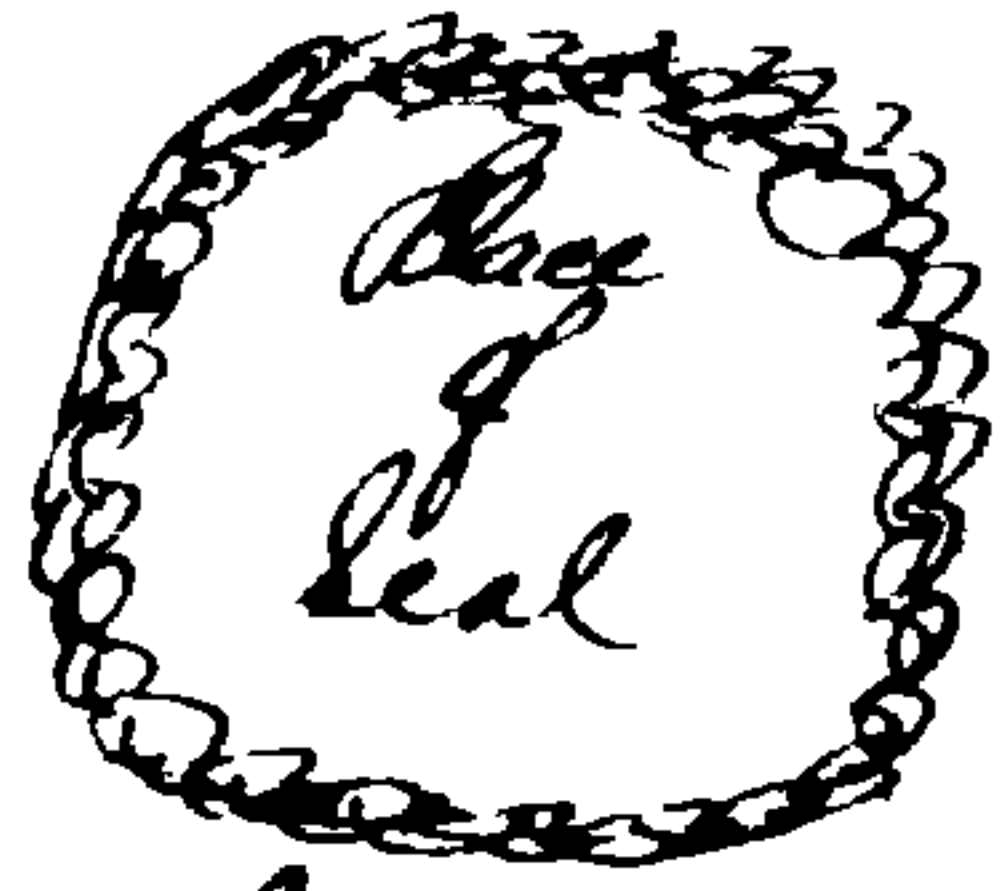

At the request of William Bell the following Deed was recorded August 19 1861. This Deed made this 25th day of April in the year 1860

By George Layman and Mary his wife of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of three thousand four hundred ninety seven dollar and fifty cents, the said George Layman and Mary his wife doth grant unto William Bell of said County and State all those pieces or parcels of Land ground situated in Frederick County which are described as follows; parts of tracts of Land called "Linton" "Bone Run Secure Run" "Naupon Plain" "Stoney Cobby" "Long Looked for come at Last" altogether containing 164 Acres of Land, the same having been conveyed to the said Geo Layman by two Deeds, the one from Benjamin A Cunningham Trustee to George Layman bearing date 10th day of June 1851 and recorded in Liber N P S No 13 folio 532^{rs} One of the Land Records of Frederick County. The other Deed Mary Meyer to George Layman bearing date 19th day of May 1851 and recorded in Liber N P S No 13 folio 533^{rs} One of the Land Records of Frederick County. Also the two tracts or parcels of ground as described in a Deed from Jacob H. Stuffer (Constable) to Geo Layman dated 25th day of November 1858 and recorded in Liber N P S No 3 folio 672, One of the Land Records of Frederick County the last two described parcels of Land containing 194 Acres of Land all the above described Lands being in fee simple.
