This Indenture made this 12th day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and forty eight between Emanuel Sifer Attorney for Henry Ashburnham of Frederick County Maryland of the one part & Barbara Castle of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witness that for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred dollars current money by the said Barbara Castle to the said Emanuel Sifer Attorney as aforesaid in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which he doth hereby acknowledge and himself to be therein fully satisfied contented and paid, the said Emanuel Sifer Attorney as aforesaid hath bargained and sold aliened and conveyed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien convey release convey and confirm unto the said Barbara Castle her heirs and assigns a certain lot of ground which was bequeathed to Sarah Kramer by Henry Parkett by his last Will and Testament and by her sold to Henry Ashburnham which will more fully appear by Deed dated 11th January 1870 & recorded in Liber A S folio 286 One of the Land Records of Frederick County Maryland, said Lot is situated in Parkerville, together with all & singular the buildings improvements ways water courses rights members privileges advantages and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and all the Estate right title and interest, trust property claim and demand whatsoever at Law and in Equity of him the said Emanuel Sifer Attorney as aforesaid or of Henry Ashburnham of us & to the same.
