Said Trustee further reports that having accepted the Trust reposed in him by said Deed of Trust, and having first filed in the Clerk's Office of your Honorable Court his duly approved Bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of \$1000.00 conditioned for the faithful performance of the Trust reposed in him by said Deed of Trust, he then proceeded to the due execution of the Trust as follows:

Ross Guardian in the sum of One thousand dollars on the 4th day of April 1877 executed his Deed of Mortgage to said Charles W.
