This Indenture made this thirtieth day of May in the year Eighteen Hun-
dred and Sixty Eight between Edward Burkett of Frederick County
in the State of Maryland of the one part and Simon C. Simmons of the
same County and State of the other part Whereas the said Edward
Burkett owes and stands bound unto the said Simon C. Simmons
by his note of hand duly executed on stamped paper bearing
date this thirtieth day of May in the year Eighteen Hundred
and Sixty Eight for the sum of Three Hundred Dollars current money
with interest from date and payable in four months after date Now
this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Edward Burkett in consid-
eration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars owing to the said Simon
C. Simmons his Executors Administrators and assigns, and also in
consideration of the further sum of One Dollar current money to the said
Edward Burkett by the said Simon C. Simmons in hand well and truly
paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt wh-
ereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Edward Burkett hath granted
conveyed and sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth
