

6th Int. Was the said James Cook at the time of his death indebted to the Complainants or either of them and if you state to what amount respectively and whether by note or open account? and has such indebtedness been paid?

Answer to 6 I can't say, except he was indebted to me in the sum of twenty five Dollars. It was an open account for services rendered. It has not been paid.

7th Int. Has there been any administration upon the Personal Estate of said James Cook, and if you by whom? and state whether the Personal Estate of said James Cook is sufficient to pay his debts? State fully all you know with reference thereto?

Answer 7th There has been by Moses Shaw. The Personal Estate was not sufficient to pay the debts of said James Cook.

8th Int. Did said James Cook leave any Children or other Heirs at Law and if you give their names, ages and places of residence, and state how related to said James Cook and whether said James Cook left a widow now living.

Answer to 8th He left Children but no widow. The Children are as follows, a Daughter Eliza Wilson, married and the name of whose husband is Robert Wilson, and resides in the State of Pennsylvania. He left Mary Smith and Martha Smith grand Children, whose parents are dead, & who are now residents of the State of Ohio, but don't know in what part of the State. He left a Daughter Catharine Matthews, a Daughter, a non-resident, and whose whereabouts is not known. He left a Daughter Louisa A. Brown who does not live in the State of Maryland & whose whereabouts is not known. He left a son William H. Cook who resides in the State of Pennsylvania. He left a son John W. Cook residing in the State of Pennsylvania. He left a Daughter Anne M. Books who is married and the name of whose Husband is Dennis Books. They reside in Frederick County. He left a Daughter Susie Cook residing in Carroll County. All of said Children and Heirs at Law are adults except Mary Smith and Martha Smith and Susie Cook who are infants under twenty one years of age.

9th Int. Do you know anything further that would be of advantage to the Complainants in this case and if you, state the same fully.
Answer Nothing further.
