

The above cause standing ready for a hearing & being submitted, the Bill, answer Exhibit testimony and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered. It is thereupon this 27th day of Feb'y in the year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Eight by the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity and by the authorities of said Court, adjudged ordered & decreed that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that Moses Shaw of Carroll County be and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course of manner of his proceedings shall be as follows he shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed by himself with a surety or sureties to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof in the penalty of One Thousand Dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of the Trust reposed in him by this Court or which may be reposed in him by any future order or decree in the premises. He shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some Newspaper printed in Frederick County and such other notice as he may think proper of the time, place manner and terms of Sale; which
