Bill filed Feb. 13. 1878.

The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the real estate situate in Frederick County, Maryland, of which a certain Daniel Fogle did seized and possessed, and for distribution of the proceeds arising therefrom amongst the parties entitled thereto according to their just proportion.
