Interrogatories to be propounded to Wilford A. Renner and Jacob Stitzel of J. Competent witnesses sworn in behalf of Complainants.

- 1st Interrogatory. State your name, age and residence.
- 2<sup>nd</sup>. Do you know the parties to this suit, if yes, how long have you known them.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>. Did you know Daniel Fogle, in his life time, if yes, how long did you know him, and is he living or dead, if dead, when did he die, and did he die testate or intestate.
- 4<sup>th</sup>. Did the said Daniel Fogle leave a widow surviving him, if yes, state her name, and is she yet living, if living, what is her age.
- 5<sup>th</sup>. Did the said Daniel Fogle leave any children or grand children surviving him, or any direct descendants.
- 6<sup>th</sup>. Did the said Daniel Fogle have any brothers or sisters, or brothers and sisters children surviving him, if yes, state their names and whether or not any of them are under twenty one years of age. Also their residences - if any of said parties are married, give the names of their husbands or wives.
- 7<sup>th</sup>. Did the said Daniel Fogle die seized and possessed of any real estate - if yes, look at Exhibits Nos. 1, 2 & 3, now shown you, and state whether, or not they contain a description of the same - Also state when said real estate is situated and its value.
- 8<sup>th</sup>. State whether or not his brother Nicholas Fogle Jr is now living or dead, if dead, when did he die, and did he die testate or intestate.
- 9<sup>th</sup>. Did the said Nicholas Fogle Jr leave a widow and children surviving him, if yes, give their names and ages and present residence.
- 10<sup>th</sup>. State whether or not the real estate of which Daniel Fogle died seized and possessed above mentioned is susceptible of division among the parties above named.
- 11<sup>th</sup>. State whether or not, it would be to the advantage of said parties, and especially the infants Emma Fogle, Charles Fogle, Annie Fogle and Margaret Fogle, to have the same sold, and the proceeds divided among them - State your reasons for this same.
