

the beginning of a deed from William Portman and wife, conveyed to the said Daniel Fogle for one acre and 25 sq. fcs of land, more or less, bearing date the 5th, day of October 1867, and recorded in Liber D 8 B No. 1, folio 737, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, aforesaid, then running with the lines of said deed reversed, viz: (2) S. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 10 $\frac{1}{10}$ fches to a stake in the root of a Hickory Stump, (3) S. 71 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 31 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stake in the margin of the Public Road leading from Woodboro' to Johnsville, then across said road, (4) N. 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 31 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a Hickory tree standing on the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ line of the deed from Jacob W. Hyde to the said Daniel Fogle, then running with the outlines of said deed, (5) S. 59° W. 7 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stone on the North side of the road, then along the North side of said road (6) S. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 8 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stone, then leaving the road, (7) N. 44 $\frac{5}{8}$ ° W. 43 fcs. to a stone, (8) N. 29 $\frac{1}{8}$ ° E. 8 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stone, (9) Due North 28 $\frac{1}{10}$ fches to a stone, then bounding on the lands of Henry Fogle 3 lines, viz: - (10) N. 88° E. 33 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stone, (11) S. 59° E. 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ fcs. to a stone, (12) N. 88° E. 15 fcs. to a stone, then (13) S. 56 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 15 $\frac{3}{10}$ fcs. to the first mentioned place of beginning containing by Calculation the quantity of 18 acres 3 rods and 38 sq. fcs. of land.

I further certify, that I also, at the request of said Commissioners on the twentieth day of June, in the year 1878, surveyed and laid off the dower of the said Margaret Fogle by metes and bounds as follows - Beginning at a stone the beginning of the parcel in the deed from John Moore and Lydia Moore his wife, to the said Danl. Fogle, bearing date the 6th, day of April 1864, and recorded as aforesaid, and running thence on a part of the first line thereof, South 62 degrees East 14 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stake, then leaving the outlines and running across the tract South 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ degrees West 12 $\frac{1}{10}$ fcs. to a stake, South 75 degrees West 8 $\frac{1}{10}$ fches to a stake, and intersecting the fifth line of said deed, then with said 5th line North 15 degrees East 9 fches to a stake at the end of said line, then North 16 degrees East 8 $\frac{3}{4}$ fches to the first mentioned place of beginning containing 3 rods and 30 square fches of land, it being the part of the said real estate of the said Daniel Fogle, dec'd. as assigned and allotted as dower to the said Margaret Fogle.

I further certify, that I have made Plans of the lands of which the said Daniel Fogle died seized and possessed, and also of the dower of the said widow Margaret Fogle as laid off by said Commissioners which I herewith return to your Honorable Court.
