In the Circuit Court for Frederick County in Equity.

The foregoing report of Thomas Clagett and Elias Zimmerman Receivers of J. E. Cartzendafner & Co and the Exhibits therewith filed, having by the Court been read and considered - It is therefore this ninth day of July 1879. Ordered by the Circuit Court for Frederick County sitting as a Court of Equity, that the receivers Thomas Clagett and Elias Zimmerman, proceed at once and make sale of all the personal chattels & property, and also the mill properties described in these proceedings - but before making sale they shall advertise the said property in one or more of the newspapers published in Frederick County, giving notice of the time place, manner and terms of sale, and also give such other notice as they shall think proper, the personal chattels & property to be advertised for at least ten days before the day of sale - and the said mill properties for at least twenty days before the day of sale, and the terms of sale for the personal chattels and property, shall be, all sums of Ten dollars and under Cash, and for all sums over ten dollars a credit of three months, the purchaser or purchasers giving his her or their notes bearing interest with approved security - and the terms of sale for said mill properties, shall be one third Cash to be paid on the day of sale, the residue in two equal annual payments the purchaser or purchasers giving his her or their notes with interest bearing date on the day of sale with approved security
And it is further ordered, that the said receivers upon making
