

in the sum of twenty two dollars and fifty cents for medical services rendered by them to the said Otelia Zellers, a copy of which account is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 2 Your Complainants further represent that the said Otelia Zellers was also indebted unto divers other persons and being so indebted she departed this life in estate sometime in the month of August A. D. 1878, that your Complainants Perry Rice and Albert S. Rice partners trading as P. & A. S. Rice provided a respectable coffin, case and other matters for the burial of the said Otelia Zellers, the cost of which amounted to the sum of fifty two dollars, which sum is properly chargeable against the estate of the said Otelia Zellers and an account of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 3 to this Bill of Complaint, that your Complainant Harriet Robinson the wife of the said Adam Robinson, prepared for burial the body of the said Otelia Zellers and has charged therefor the sum of ten dollars, an account of which is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 4 to this Bill of Complaint.

Your Complainants further represents that the said Otelia Zellers at the time of her death was seized and possessed of certain real estate situated, lying and being in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, which was conveyed to her by deed from Joshua Lovell and wife, a certified copy of which deed as recorded among the said Records of Frederick County is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 5 and wherein a full description of thereof is contained and that the said Otelia Zellers also left a small personal estate.

Your Complainants further represent and charge that administration of all and singular the personal estate of the said Otelia Zellers hath been lately granted by the Orphans Court of Frederick County unto one Christian H. Eckstein of said County, a certified copy of which administration is herewith filed marked Exhibit No 6 to this Bill of Complaint, who in virtue thereof has possessed himself of said personal estate and has sold the same under the directions of said Orphans Court, which sale amounted to the sum of forty dollars and some few cents, which amount will be considerably lessened by costs to be paid out of it and which is all the personal estate to be administered.

Your Complainants further represent and charge that the sums of money abovementioned are yet due and unpaid to your Complainants that the personal estate left by the said Otelia Zellers is totally insufficient to pay her just debts among which are your Complainants and that any deficiency in the said personal estate ought to be supplied by a sale of the real estate of their deceased debtor.

Your Complainants further represent and charge that the said Otelia Zellers left surviving her as her heirs at law one Rudolph Blank who has been married with some one whose name is unknown to your Complainants and who is a brother of the said Otelia Zellers, and also other heirs, whose names and residences (if they are living) are unknown to your Complainants, and if dead, whose legal representatives or their residences your Complainants are ignorant of beyond this that they do not live within the state of Maryland, and that the said Rudolph Blank and wife resides within the German Empire and does not reside within the State of Maryland - and that upon said heirs at law all the interest of the said Otelia Zellers in said abovementioned real estate has devolved.
