Eckstein may set forth an account of the personal estate of the said intestate possessed by him and that an account may be taken under the direction of this Court of the said debts so as aforesaid due to your complainants; and of all the debts owing by the said intestate and yet unpaid, and that the aforesaid real estate, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose, may be decreed to be sold, for the payment of so much of the aforesaid debts as may remain unsatisfied by the application of the personal estate as aforesaid, and that your complainants may have such further and other relief as their case may require.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your complainants the writ of Subpoena against the said Christian H Eckstein, commanding him to appear in this Honorable Court to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein - And also to further grant unto your complainants an order of publication giving notice to the said Rudolph Blank and wife whose name is unknown and the other heirs whose names are unknown non-residents of the state of Maryland of the object and substance of this bill of complaint and warning them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on or before a certain day to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein and as in duty bound will ever pray &
