The object of this suit is to procure a decree for the sale of the real estate situate in Frederick County, Maryland, of which certain Otelia Jellers died seized and possessed and to apply the proceeds thereof to the payment of the debts of the said Otelia Jellers, late of Frederick County.

The Bill states that the said Otelia Jellers deceased was in her life time indebted unto the Complainant Francis J. Burck in the sum of thirty four dollars for medical services rendered by the said Francis J. Burck as a physician to the said Otelia Jellers.

The Bill further states that the said Otelia Jellers in her life time was also indebted unto the complainants Charles Smith and Frank S. Smith partners trading as Hrs. Charles & F. S. Smith in the sum of twenty two dollars and fifty cents for medical services rendered by them to the said Otelia Jellers.

The Bill further states that the said Otelia Jellers was also indebted unto divers other persons and being so indebted she departed this life intestate in the month of August A. D. 1878.

The Bill further states that the complainants Perry Rice and Albert S. Rice, partners trading as P & A. S. Rice provided a coffin, case, and other matters for the burial of the said Otelia Jellers, amounting to the sum of fifty two dollars, which sum it is charged is properly chargeable in account against the Estate of the said Otelia Jellers.

The Bill further states that the complainant Harriet Robinson prepared for burial the body of the said Otelia Jellers and has charged therefor the sum of ten dollars.

The Bill further represents that the said Otelia Jellers at the time of her death was seized and possessed of certain real estate situated lying and being in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, which was conveyed to her by
