Mollie Munston

1st Interrogatory: State your name, age and residence?

Answer. I did. She is dead. I knowed her for the last seven years.

3d Interrogatory. Did she leave any real estate? If yea, where is it situated?

Answer. She did. It is situated in Middle Alley, Frederick City Maryland.

4th Interrogatory: Do you know Doctors Charles & Frank F. Smith? If yea, how long have you known them? What is their profession, and are they partners, or not?

Answer: Yes sir I have known them for several years. They are physicians I don't know whether they are partners.
