This Indenture made this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty four, Between Prudence Oehlman of Frederick County, in the state of Maryland of the one part and Henry Baker of the same County and State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Prudence Oehlman for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, current money to her in hand paid by the said Henry Baker the receipt whereof she doth hereby acknowledge hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell, alien, enfeoff, and confirm unto the said Henry Baker, his heirs and assigns, all the following named Lots of ground, or parcels of Land, situate lying and being in the County aforesaid, in the town of Liberty, Beginning for the said Lots, at a line marked S. B. M. and running thence North four degrees, West three hundred feet, South Eighty six degrees, West two hundred and seventy feet, South four degrees, East three hundred feet, then by a straight line along the North side of the Main Street of the town of Liberty to the place of beginning, Containing in quantity equal to five lots & twenty feet (front) of the lots of the said town of Liberty, being the same Lots or parcels of Land conveyed to George Oehlman by deeds of John Brightwell, David Plaw, Joseph Hloten and Catharine Hloten his wife and Abraham Jones, a reference being had to the said deeds, recorded in the Land Records of Frederick County, in Liber W.
