At the request of H. Baker the following deed was recorded May 24 1859

This deed made this 28th day of April in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty nine by Francis S Jones of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth that in consideration of one dollar dollars, the said Francis S. Jones does grant to Henry Baker of the County and State aforesaid, the following described piece parcel or strip of land, lying in the County aforesaid and being part of "Clukes Woods" and part of "Howards Paradise". Beginning at the end of the first line of that part of "Howards Paradise" which was conveyed by the said Henry Baker to the said F. S. Jones & running thence with the lines of said conveyance reversed, North thirty eight degrees, West three fourths of a perch to a stone, North eighty two and a half degrees West twenty three and nine tenths perches to a stone, South seventeen and a half degrees West nineteen and eighty five hundredths perches South one & thirty five hundredths South eighty six degrees West twelve & one tenth perches to said Bakers town yard, then North forty five degrees West one & one fourth perches to the North side of the lane, as now fenced and running thence with the fence around to the place of beginning including a strip of land wide enough for a wagon road connecting said Bakers town yard with his part of "Howards Paradise".
