Fifthly, to the payment of a note payable to Daniel Baker & Son, and by them endorsed to H. C. Burton & Co, dated Dec. 6th 1878 at four months for Twelve hundred and forty one dollars and ninety eight cents

Sixthly, to the payment of a note dated December 14th, 1878 payable to Hayden & Hook at four months for Eight hundred and forty eight dollars and Eleven cents. Seventhly, to the payment of two notes of said Henry Baker payable to himself and by him endorsed to Hayden & Hook, One for the sum of Three hundred and Eighty eight dollars and twenty nine cents dated Sept 27th 1878 at 4 months, the other for the sum of Three hundred and Eighty six dollars and forty four cents dated October 11th, 1878 at 4 months

Eighthly, to the payment of the sum of One thousand dollars to John H. Casin in part of the claim which he holds against me for money due him on note. Ninthly, then in trust to apply the residue of the said Trust funds after the payment of the claims against the said Henry Baker heretofore recited, to the payment and satisfaction of all debts claims and demands due to the creditors of the said Henry Baker pari passu and without preference or priority, and if any surplus remain after the payment of all debts due by said Henry Baker then to pay the same to the said Henry Baker or to his assigns

And whereas the said Henry Baker has been and is now extensively engaged in the business of tanning hides and leathers, the said Trustees and the survivor of them are hereby empowered for the benefit of the said estate to conduct and carry on the said process of tanning the present stock on hand, and complete and secure the same for market, and when secured sell the same for the benefit of said estate, and upon the trusts aforesaid. And whereas the said Henry Baker has agreed with Daniel Baker & Son to tan and secure for the said Daniel Baker & Son Two hundred hides, and the same are now in the possession of the said Henry Baker, and in process of tanning, the said Trustees are hereby empowered to carry out and execute the contract and agreement with the said Daniel Baker & Son, upon the terms and conditions of said agreement between the said Henry Baker and the said Daniel Baker & Son, and do all other acts requisite to be done in the premises as full as the said Henry Baker might or could do if these presents had not been executed.
